Dear representatives of the "Parties members of the Co-ordination Council of qualified parties of Georgia",

I thank you for your letter dated 25 July.

As I have previously stressed, the Venice Commission is convinced that a solution has to be found through dialogue among the political forces of Georgia, with the aim of reaching the broadest possible consensus.

It is not the role of the Venice Commission to propose a solution; however, if the political forces of Georgia are willing to meet to discuss a possible compromise, the Venice Commission is ready to facilitate such discussions.

Having been in contact also with the representatives of the ruling majority of Georgia, I am in the position to offer to organise a one-day meeting in Strasbourg, on 6 September 2017, gathering the representatives of the ruling coalition as well as of the opposition parties.

I encourage you and the representatives of all the political parties of Georgia to use this opportunity to find a constructive compromise.
